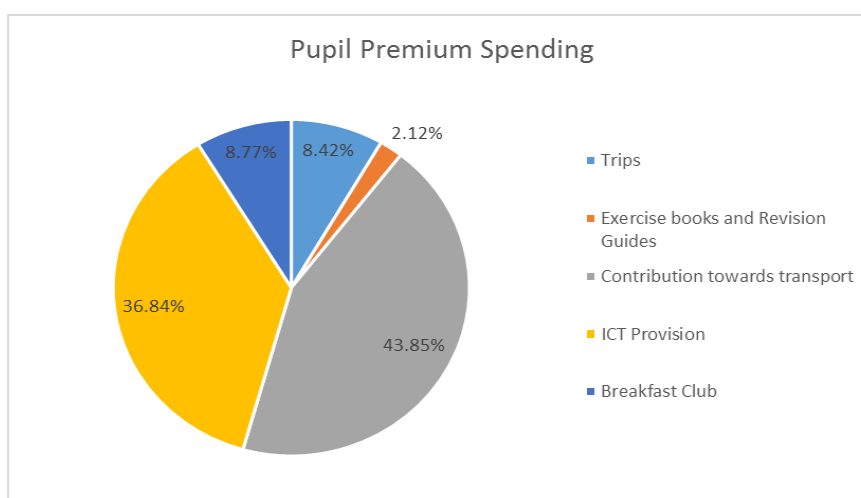

UTC Cambridge is committed to ensuring all learners make the best possible progress however

- The provision of money towards text books and revision guides ensured these learners were able to participate in lessons fully and independently study
- Contribution towards essential trips assisted the learners with their studies and revision of particular topics.
- Contribution towards the cost of transport improved the learners' attendance and ensured they were able to access their lessons on time.
- Personal ICT provision enabled learners to work independently or part of a team on either learning or researching different topics.
- The provision of the breakfast club has ensured that all learners have access to breakfast each morning. This helped learners achieve their best in lessons.

## **Impact in educational attainment**

UTC Cambridge has in place procedures for the assessment, tracking, monitoring and support systems for each learner eligible to pupil premium. The progress of each student is monitored and in particular the impact that each initiative funded by Pupil Premium has on the outcomes for disadvantaged students.
